Doctoral Dissertations and Master's Theses

General Format

Author. (Year). **Title of dissertation**. Doctoral dissertation or Master's thesis. University.

Example

Ross, D. F. (1990). **Unconscious transference and mistaken identity: When a 7 witness misidentifies a familiar but innocent person from a lineup**. Doctoral dissertation. Cornell University.

Conference paper as part of a book in proceedings

General Format

Author. (Year). Title of paper. **Title of conference (Pages)**. Place: publisher.

Example

Muelbauer, J. (2007, September). Housing, credit, and consumer expenditure. **In Housing and consumer behavior**. (pp. 1-10). Kansas City, WY: Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City.

Website

General Format

Author. (Year). **Title**. Retrieved from URL
